It is a strict fast. *In keeping with the tradition of our St. John of San Francisco, the Supplicatory Canon to the Mother of God (Paraklesis) will be chanted throughout the Dormition Fast. *On Saturday, August 19, the Transfiguration of the Lord will be celebrated with a Divine Liturgy, Vigil the evening preceding. *On Monday, August 28, the Dormition of the Theotokos will be celebrated with a Divine Liturgy, Vigil the evening preceding. *Father Nectarios will be traveling with the Wonderworking Iveron Icon from August 11th to August 15th.
